Every day there are shipments of toxic materials on our highways and railroads. A fire or explosion in a warehouse containing these materials or an accident involving the containers holding them can be deadly. **Janeen Rich** Coordinator/Instructor from the Governor's Office of Emergency Services gave a very informational program as to how these incidents are handled.

Hazmet responders are on call 24/7 and their first action is to determine the material that is involved in the incident. This can be done by using the shipping document, numbered placard or orange panel number. All shipments of hazardous materials are required to be marked with these placards. The priorities at a toxic spill incident are first human, second environment and third

property. We were told to **SIN** if we are near or involved in an incident. **Safety, Isolate, Notification**. When calling 911 you should remember the three **W's**. Who, What and Where. Finally, if you are near an incident, you want to head upwind from the incident as rapidly as possible.
